

# THE THOMAS JEFFERSON FACULTY PRIZE

## Nomination Form

This award has been established to recognize tenured or tenure-track faculty who have demonstrated excellence in research and creative activity or made other significant achievements that might not be recognized in the usual university reward system. In accordance with the guidelines used in establishing the Jefferson Prize, preference will be given to faculty members working in fields for which external funding is limited. The prize, \$6,000 per year for a one-, two-, or three-year period, may be used as the recipient wishes to support teaching, research, or public service. The prize is not a salary supplement.

Selection of Prize recipients will be made by the Chancellor on the basis of nominations forwarded by the deans. Colleges which have departmental structures may submit no more than one nomination per department. Small colleges and independent schools without departments are limited to one nomination. The deadline for materials to be received in the Office of the Provost is the first Monday in February.
