




WHAT OUR VOLS SAY

- Students may fear the uncertain future, but some know their path while others don't.
- Experiences vary widely for each student, depending on year, academic major, and first-gen status.
- These differences can impact feelings of inclusion, preparedness, anxiety, and disconnection.
- Students feel only 6.3 out of 10 prepared for the future.
- Focusing on underclassmen can reduce junior-year stressors.
- 64% of students would participate in a career-readiness program.
