### **GUARANTEED ADMISSION PROGRAM**

#### UT, KNOXVILLE GUARANTEED ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR FALL 2025

In-state applicants must achieve a **24+ ACT composite** (19+ Math and English subscore) OR **1160+ SAT** (510+ Math and 500+ English, Reading, and Writing) *AND* earn a **4.0+ UT Core GPA** OR be among the **Top 10%** of their high school graduating class.


TENNESSEE APPLICANTS WHO MEET GUARANTEED ADMISSION CRITERIA

4,435

Students have until November 15<sup>th</sup> to complete an application to be fully considered for Guaranteed Admission. As of the November 15<sup>th</sup> completion deadline, an expected 5,250 – 6,000 applicants will qualify for the Guaranteed Admission program for Fall 2025. In-state students who do not qualify for Guaranteed Admission will be reviewed using UT's holistic review process.

### FLAGSHIP PROGRAM | EXPANDED IMPACT

Effective for Fall 2025 incoming scholars, UT has increased the number of Flagship High Schools to 52 with the addition of 14 high schools to the Flagship Scholarship Program (currently 38 high schools) from 11 counties.


