Student Success

- 97.6% spring persistence for fall 2024 cohort
- More than 90% of the 2024 graduating class reported they are either employed or continuing their education
- 95% of first-year scholars in positive academic standing at the end of fall 2024
- 130,000+ visits to the Vol Study Center so far this year
- We continue to see record applications this cycle with more than **62,000**.







Student Life

Volunteers are more engaged in and out of the classroom than ever before.

- 27% increase in use of RecSports facilities; 78% increase in intramural and club sport participation
- 30% increase in Greek Life participation
- 55% increase in returning student housing applications
- 42% increase in Student Union foot traffic
- 71.5% increase in group therapy and 50.9% increase in intake sessions; referrals through 974-HELP doubled between 2019 and 2024.








High-Impact Research in Service of Tennessee

Our expertise in critical research areas along with strong industry and government partnerships have positioned UT to grow our impact.

- \$386.9 million in research expenditures for FY24
- Five faculty entrepreneurs received \$50,000 awards to advance their technology in the second annual Chancellor's Innovation Awards
- Four UT researchers named AAAS Fellows
- **Seven** faculty named among the most highly-cited researchers in the world.




Best Athletics Department in the Country

Our competitive excellence and our principled, visionary leadership have made UT a top athletics department.

- Four sports have finished in the top 10 nationally so far this year: football, men's basketball, men's swimming and women's swimming.
- UT led the nation in combined attendance across football and both basketball seasons.
- Football season ticket sold out for third straight year, and combined TV viewership in 2023-24 was 1.4 billion
- Third straight year of record revenue, with \$234M in FY24
- All student-athletes posted an overall combined GPA of 3.38, the second-best semester in school history..
